Guess who's playing King Lear!!



There will be a 15 minute intermission between plays. The wine bar and snack bar will be open 1 hour before each session and during intermissions. The upstairs wine bar will remain open until the beginning of the Adjudication. There are light refreshments on the bar, primarily for the casts and crews of the session, but if there is extra food, please help yourself.

The public adjudications will be held following the last play of each session. Everyone is invited to listen, though comments are not allowed. Please note the location of the adjudications:

- The adjudications for both evening performances will take place in the theatre.
- The detailed adjudications for the <u>Saturday afternoon</u> plays will take place at the Perth Restaurant, 23 Gore Street W. Turn left as you exit the theatre, right on Gore Street, cross the bridge, cross Herriot Street, and The Perth Restaurant is in the middle of the block. You could order dinner there too.

If you've seen all 9 plays, please fill out a **People's Choice Award** ballot that came in your ticket package and drop them in the boxes provided before you leave the theatre after the final session.

The Awards Brunch will be held Sunday, November 3rd at the Crystal Palace, located adjacent to the rear parking lot of the theatre. Doors open at 10 am; brunch will be served at 11 am.
